We believe that through combining these concepts, students will be able to maximise their learning experience in a short space of time and build the competencies that will help them succeed in the future.

Throughout the course, there is a strong focus on student interaction, the sharing of different ideas and cultures, and authentic communication. Students collaborate with peers from various nationalities, enhancing their English proficiency while acquiring new skills, and gaining a deeper understanding of the subject matter in a multi-cultural learning environment.

In addition to skills-based lessons, each course ends with a group project whereby students are guided by our expert teachers throughout the programme to present their projects in a grand finale.

- The Academy scholars present a cultural project based on places they have visited during the programme and research that they have done into the historical significance of these destinations.
- Young Entrepreneurs take part in a 'pitching competition' where they pitch their innovative business plans to their peers and a panel of judges.
- Young University Scholars engage in an academic research project and present their findings to peers at the end of the course.

These projects are designed to develop a wide range of skills that are beneficial to our students' academic and professional futures.

Content And Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)

CLIL is a central part of the Global Futures philosophy. It is an innovative educational approach that combines the teaching of subject content with language and communication skills, fostering a more holistic, engaging and relevant learning experience.

The approach incorporates a variety of interactive methods such as workshops, masterclasses, seminars, and hands-on activities. These methods help students to engage deeply with the material, making learning more dynamic and enjoyable.

CLIL encourages students to think critically and creatively. This dual focus challenges students to apply their language skills to complex subject matter, enhancing their problem solving abilities and innovative thinking.

CLIL prepares students for real-life scenarios by bridging the gap between academic learning and practical application. This preparation is invaluable for future careers, as students are trained to apply and use their communication skills in various practical contexts.

Problem-Based Learning (PBL): A Dynamic Approach to Education

Problem-Based Learning (PBL) is a student-centered approach that focuses on active engagement, critical thinking, and collaborative problem-solving. In PBL, students are presented with real-world problems or challenges that are relevant to their learning objectives. They work in small groups to explore and analyse the problem, identify possible solutions, and apply their knowledge and skills to develop creative and effective solutions.

Key Principles of PBL:

- **Authentic Problems:** PBL begins with the presentation of authentic, real-world problems that are complex, open-ended, and relevant to the students' interests and learning objectives.
- **Student-Centered Learning:** PBL shifts the focus from the teacher as the primary source of knowledge to the students as active participants in their own learning.
- **Collaborative Learning:** PBL emphasises collaboration and teamwork, with students working together in small groups to brainstorm ideas, share perspectives, and collectively solve problems. Collaboration fosters communication skills, empathy, and respect for diverse viewpoints.
- **Inquiry and Exploration:** PBL encourages students to engage in inquiry-based learning, asking questions, seeking information, and exploring multiple perspectives to deepen their understanding of the problem. Inquiry promotes critical thinking, curiosity, and a desire for lifelong learning.
- **Application of Knowledge:** PBL integrates knowledge and skills with real-world application, allowing students to see the relevance and significance of what they are learning.
- **Reflection and Feedback:** PBL encourages reflection on the learning process, including the identification of strengths, weaknesses, and areas for improvement.
- **Presentation and Evaluation:** Students present their solutions to their peers, instructors, or external stakeholders, articulating their rationale, process, and outcomes. Feedback is provided to assess the quality of the solutions and identify areas for improvement.

In summary, Problem-Based Learning (PBL) offers a dynamic and student-centred approach to education that promotes active learning, critical thinking, collaboration, and real-world application.

By engaging students in authentic problems and empowering them to explore and solve challenges, PBL prepares students to succeed in an ever-changing world.

- Offer personalised assistance from experienced teachers to help students navigate the complexities of the application process and plot their pathway to future.

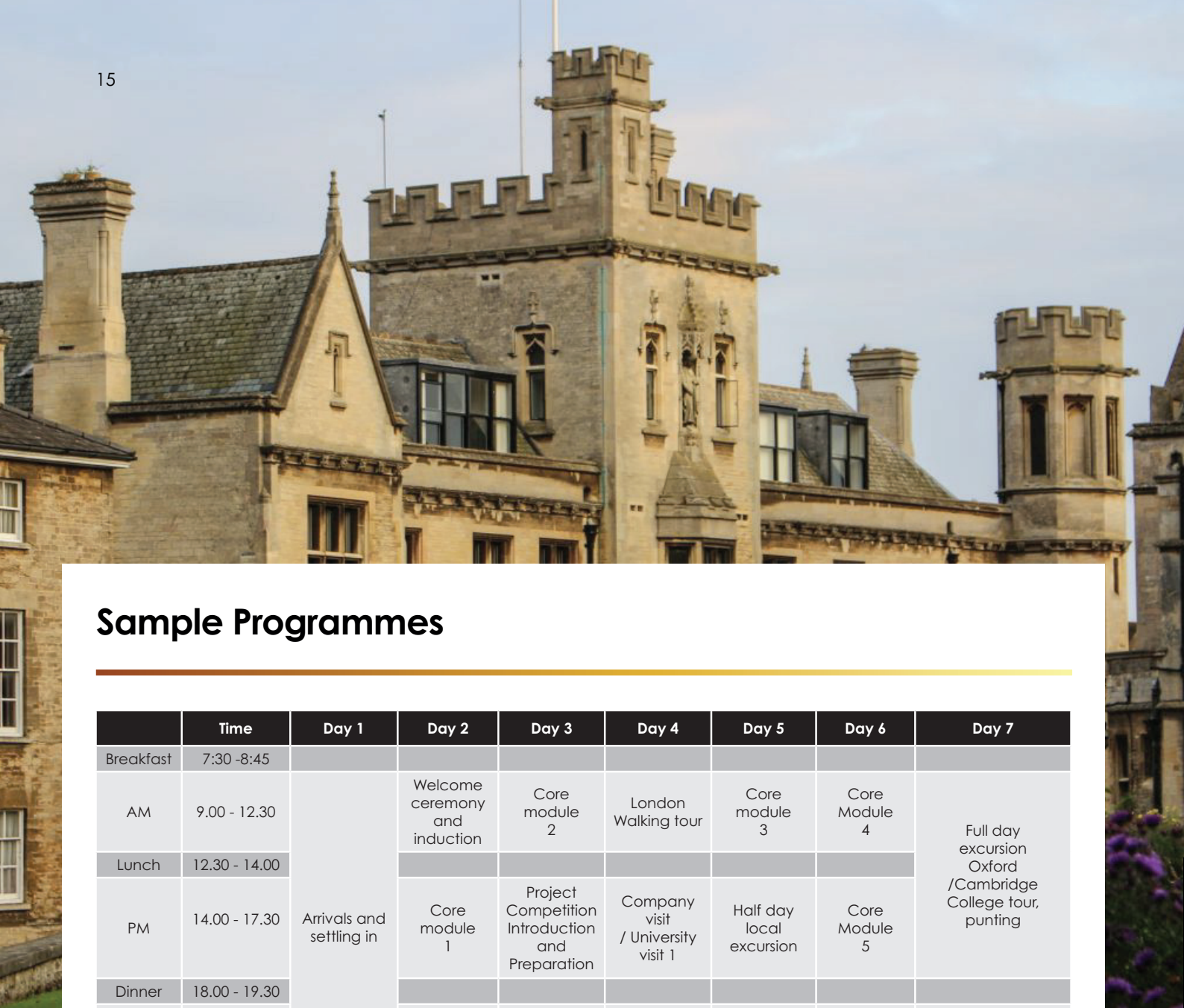
Career Exploration:
